I shall, as a firefighter, regard myself as a member of an important and honorable profession.

I shall conduct both my personal and official life so as to inspire the confidence of the public in a professional manner

I shall not use my profession and my position of trust for personal advantage or profit.

I shall regard my fellow firefighters with the same standards as I hold for myself.

I shall regard it my duty to know my profession thoroughly. It is my further duty to avail myself of every opportunity to learn more about my profession.

I shall avoid alliances with those whose goals are inconsistent with the mission statement of the Campbellsport Fire Department

I shall make no claim to professional qualifications which I do not possess.

I shall share all publicity equally with my fellow firefighters, whether such publicity is favorable or unfavorable.

I shall be loyal to my superiors, to my subordinates, and to the department I represent.

I shall constantly bear in mind that the truth is to be sought before the case is made, so that the stature of Wisconsin firefighters be enhanced rather than tarnished.

I shall judge fellow firefighters by standards I myself hold, and never jeopardize the safety of any fellow firefighters.

I shall cautiously avoid any conduct, which might compromise the integrity of my fellow firefighters or the department, and have the obligation to report the dishonesty of others.

I shall never act impertinent or permit personal feelings, prejudices, animosities or friendships to influence decisions.

I shall obey all Federal, State and Local laws.

I shall be familiar with and obedient to the house rules, by laws and the standard operating guidelines under which the department is governed.

I shall not release details of any emergency operation or investigation without express permission of the Chief.

I shall above all, conduct myself with the best interests of the Campbellsport Fire Department and the public we serve in mind at all times.
